## **Dua upon wearing New Clothes**

Hazrat Abu Saeed Al-Khudri RadhiAllahu Anhu narrated that "When the Messenger of Allah (SallAllahu Alaihi Wasallam) would wear a new garment he would mention what it was, whether an 'amamah (Turban), a Qamis (shirt), or a Rida'(robe), then he would say:

Allahumma lakal hamdo Anta kasautanihe, as'aloka min khairehi wa khaire ma sune'a lahu, wa aauzo beka min sharrehi wa sharre ma sune'a lahu.

Translation: O Allah, praise be to You! as You have clothed me with it, I ask You for its good and the good of that for which it was made, and I seek refuge in You from its evil and the evil of that for which it was made. (Abu Dawood, Tirmizi)
