Dua during a Wind Storm

1. Allahumma innee as'aluka khairaha, wa aauzu beka min sharreha.

Translation:

O Allah, indeed, I ask You for its good, and I seek refuge in You from its evil. (Abu Dawood, Ibne Majah)

2. Allahumma innee as'aluka khairaha wa khaira ma feeha wa khaira ma urselat behi, wa auzubeka min sharreha wa sharre ma fiha, wa sharre ma urselat bih.

Translation:

'O Allah, indeed, I ask You for its good, the good of what is in it, and the good of what it has been sent with. And I seek refuge in You from its evil, the evil of what is in it, and the evil of what it has been sent with. (Bukhari, Muslim)
